



## Fiberglass Contamination Checklist

### Immediately

- Isolate the mattress
  - Even if Fiberglass is everywhere it can leak more
- Call a Remediation Company (Professional Cleaning)
  - Many clients use Serve Pro, but they are in no way affiliated with Cueto Law
- Contact your doctor

### Do ASAP

- Relocate if needed/able to
- Remove Mattress once it is properly sealed
  - Mark Clearly as Hazard
- Contact Homeowner/Renters insurance (this is often not covered)
- Contact Heating and Cooling Service Company
  - Do not turn on HVAC till house and system are decontaminated
  - Replace systems if needed
- Contact Repairman for affected appliances (washer, drier etc)
- Contact Vet for affected pets

### Deep Cleaning

- Dispose of all contaminated items
  - Usually all soft items including (clothing, toys, bedding, curtains, rugs, carpets, upholstered furniture etc)
- Clean all surfaces including walls

### Car

- Assess car for spill over contamination
- Contact detailing service to replace carpets and upholstery

### Legal Matters

- Keep all bills, invoices and estimates (including medical bills)
- Take pictures of mattress, tags, damage/contamination to home, self, family and pets
- Keep a list of all discarded items
