



## Signs of Discrimination Against Students

### From Teachers

- Low grades that don't reflect your child's performance
- Not implementing or ignoring your child's IEP (Individualized Education Program)
- Child is ignored in class
- Disciplined for small matters
- Being singled out negatively
- Refusal to make reasonable accommodations for disabilities or language barriers
- Other actions that create a hostile environment

### From School Administration

- Not following up on reports of bullying
- Administering harsh or unreasonable punishments
- Discipling child for small matters
- Ignorning reports of discrimination or bullying
- Recommending students with disabilities transfer
- Not sending home translated paperwork or flyers
- Not offering translators for conferences or meetings
- Other actions that create a hostile environment

### From District

- Not offering training and seminars for staff in Acceptance, tolerance, and Special Education
- Recommending all students with disabilities go to the same school
- Not responding to reports of discrimination in schools
- Refusing to create or implement an IEP for your child
- Multiple reports of discrimination across schools in the district

### What to Do Legally

- Keep records of all incidents of discrimination
- Keep records of all communication with teachers, administrators, and the district.
